## LAKE SONOMA WINERY 2009 DRY CREEK SAUVIGNON BLANC



### Wine Description

Intense, fresh aromas of lime zest, tamarind and guava, followed up by crisp acidity, vibrant citrus flavors and hints of tarragon and freshly cut grass.

### Winemaker Notes

This wine was made from some of the best Sauvignon Blanc vineyards in Sonoma County; Dry Creek Valley is known for its top-quality Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Harvested at the peak of flavor, the grapes are gently pressed and then cold fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve their crisp, fruity flavors.

No barrels or malolactic fermentation were used during the winemaking process. This approach allowed the full expression of the grape's clean, fresh character.

### Food Recommendations

This lively, refreshing wine is an excellent pairing for shellfish and ceviche, spicy Asian dishes and summer salads.
